WHEREAS, By The Will of Divine Providence, our beloved former member, the Honorable Hackett D. Smartt, departed this life on April 2, 1991, at the age of 98; and

WHEREAS, Representative Smartt was born August 18, 1892, in Smartt Station, Tennessee; and

WHEREAS, Representative Smartt was a farmer in Prowers county, Colorado; and

WHEREAS, Representative Smartt was the first local agent of the State Farm Automobile Insurance Company in Lamar; and

WHEREAS, Representative Smartt served as president of the Prowers county farm bureau for ten years and as its state director for approximately twenty years; and

WHEREAS, Representative Smartt served as secretary of the Arkansas River Compact administration for Colorado and Kansas; and

WHEREAS, Representative Smartt served this state faithfully as a member of the House of Representatives from 1949 through 1954 representing Prowers county; and

WHEREAS, Representative Smartt was a member of numerous house committees, including Livestock, Irrigation and Water Resource, Highways, and Appropriations; and

WHEREAS, It is fitting that we, the members of the Fifty-eighth General Assembly, pay tribute to the years of dedicated public service of Representative Smartt and express our deep regret and sorrow occasioned by his death; now, therefore,

*Be It Resolved by the House of Representatives of the Fifty-eighth General Assembly of the State of Colorado, the Senate concurring herein:*

That, in the death of Hackett D.
