

## M. Keith Singer, ex-legislator, lawyer, dies

**M. KEITH SINGER**, Denver lawyer and former Colorado legislator, died July 5 in University Hospital. He was 60.

A memorial service will be at 10:30 a.m. Monday, July 11, in the Basilica of the Immaculate Conception, 1530 Logan St.

Mr. Singer served three terms in the Colorado House as the Republican repre-

sentative from Jefferson County District 24 from 1964 to 1970, serving on the health, welfare and institutions and judiciary and local government committees.

He was born Dec. 4, 1927, in Colorado Springs and graduated from the University of Colorado and the University of Denver Law School.

He is survived by his wife, Molly Kay Singer of Arvada; two sons, Michael Singer of Sterling and Mark Singer of Denver; three daughters, Melanie Singer, Megan Singer and Kate Norris, all of Denver; two sisters, Mary McCaw of Denver and Jean Singer of Albuquerque; and a brother, John Singer of Ramona, Calif.
