## Annual Executive Summary of Audits of Tobacco Settlement Programs

Members of the Legislative Audit Committee:

Section 2-3-113(5), C.R.S., requires the State Auditor to provide an annual executive summary to the Legislative Audit Committee of evaluations conducted on tobacco settlement programs. Section 2-3-113(2), C.R.S., requires that the evaluations assess whether the tobacco settlements programs meet their stated goals efficiently and effectively.

Listed below are the most recent performance audits and evaluations the Office of the State Auditor (OSA) has completed of tobacco settlement programs.

- Colorado State Veteran's Trust Fund Grant Program (May 2014). This audit resulted in five findings and 19 specific recommendations.
- Colorado HIV and AIDS Prevention Grant Program (July 2013). This audit resulted in five findings and 23 specific recommendations.

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- A performance audit of the Colorado Immunization Program at the Department of Public Health and Environment.
