A BILL FOR AN ACT

101 CONCERNING PROHIBITION OF THE NEGLIGENT STORAGE OF FIREARMS.

Bill Summary

(Note: This summary applies to this bill as introduced and does not necessarily reflect any amendments that may be subsequently adopted.)

Makes it a class 3 misdemeanor if a person negligently stores a firearm in such a manner that a juvenile obtains possession of the firearm and uses it to commit a criminal offense.

1 Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado: 2 **SECTION 1.** Article 12 of title 18, Colorado Revised Statutes, 3 is amended BY THE ADDITION OF A NEW SECTION to read: 4 18-12-111. Negligent storage of firearms. (1) A PERSON 5 COMMITS A CLASS 3 MISDEMEANOR IF SUCH PERSON NEGLIGENTLY STORES 6 A FIREARM IN SUCH A MANNER THAT A JUVENILE OBTAINS POSSESSION OF 7 THE FIREARM AND USES THE FIREARM IN VIOLATION OF ANY PROVISION OF 8 THIS TITLE OR ANY MUNICIPAL ORDINANCE OR COUNTY RESOLUTION. 9 (2) FOR PURPOSES OF THIS SECTION, "NEGLIGENTLY STORES" 10 MEANS TO PLACE OR LEAVE A FIREARM IN A LOCATION WHERE A 11 REASONABLE PERSON WOULD PERCEIVE A SUBSTANTIAL AND 12 UNJUSTIFIABLE RISK THAT A JUVENILE WOULD OBTAIN POSSESSION OF THE

SECTION 2. Effective date - applicability. This act shall take
effect upon passage, and shall apply to offenses committed on or after
said date.

5 SECTION 3. Safety clause. The general assembly hereby finds,
6 determines, and declares that this act is necessary for the immediate
7 preservation of the public peace, health, and safety.
