TITLE: CONCERNING A REQUIREMENT THAT INFORMATION IDENTIFYING PERSONS WHO HOLD PERMITS TO CARRY CONCEALED WEAPONS BE KEPT CONFIDENTIAL.

Summary of Assessment

This bill would require that information identifying concealed weapon permit holders be kept confidential. The bill also includes information identifying concealed weapon permit holders within the definition of "criminal justice records." The bill requires that information identifying a concealed weapon permit holder be deleted from a criminal justice record prior to releasing the record to an individual or agency other than a criminal justice agency. The bill would take effect upon signature of the Governor.

The Colorado Bureau of Investigation, Department of Public Safety, currently maintains confidentiality of protected records. The bill can be implemented by the Bureau within existing resources. Therefore, the bill is assessed as having no fiscal impact.
