After consideration on the merits, the Committee recommends the following:

SB00-125 be amended as follows, and as so amended, be referred to the Committee on Appropriations with favorable recommendation:

1 Amend reengrossed bill, page 8, strike line 18 and substitute the
2 following:

3 "DENIED.

4 (c) IN THE CASE OF ANY TRANSFER DENIED PURSUANT TO
5 PARAGRAPH (b) OF SUBSECTION (3) OF THIS SECTION, THE INABILITY OF THE
6 TRANSFEREE TO OBTAIN THE FINAL DISPOSITION OF A CASE THAT IS NO
7 LONGER PENDING SHALL NOT CONSTITUTE THE BASIS FOR THE CONTINUED
8 DENIAL OF THE TRANSFER SO LONG AS THE TRANSFEREE PROVIDES A
9 CERTIFIED STATEMENT SIGNED BY THE CLERK OF THE COURT THAT
10 INDICATES THAT NO FINAL CASE DISPOSITION INFORMATION IS AVAILABLE.
11 UPON PRESENTATION OF SUCH STATEMENT TO THE BUREAU, THE BUREAU
12 SHALL REVERSE THE DENIAL.

13 (d) IF THE BUREAU REVERSES A DENIAL, THE BUREAU SHALL "

14 Page 13, line 2, strike "In" and substitute "(1) In";

15 after line 9, insert the following:

16 "(2) In addition to any other appropriation, there is hereby
17 appropriated, out of any moneys in the general fund not otherwise
18 appropriated, to the department of public safety, for the fiscal year
19 beginning July 1, 2000, the sum of one million sixty-five thousand four
20 hundred eighty dollars (\$1,065,480) and 19.0 FTE, or so much thereof as
21 may be necessary, for the implementation of this act."
