Amend reengrossed bill, page 2, line 3, strike "(7), and (9)," and substitute "(7), (9), and (10) (a),".

Page 5, line 4, after the second "OF", insert "THE BEGINNING OF";

after line 24, insert the following:

"(10) (a) No later than October 1 of any given calendar year commencing on or after January 1, 2001, the executive director shall annually adjust the dollar amount specified in this subsection (10) SUBSECTION (9) OF THIS SECTION to reflect the rate of growth of Colorado personal income for the calendar year immediately preceding the calendar year in which such adjustment is made. For purposes of this paragraph (a),"the rate of growth of Colorado personal income" means the percentage change between the most recent published annual estimate of total personal income for Colorado, as defined and officially reported by the bureau of economic analysis in the United States department of commerce for the calendar year immediately preceding the calendar year in which the adjustment is made and the most recent published annual estimate of total personal income for Colorado, as defined and officially reported by the bureau of economic analysis in the United States department of commerce for the calendar year prior to the calendar year immediately preceding the calendar year prior to the calendar year immediately preceding the calendar year in which the adjustment is made."
