A BILL FOR AN ACT

101 **CONCERNING THE USE OF GENERAL FUND MONEYS BY PROBATION**
102 **DEPARTMENTS TO NOTIFY VICTIMS OF INFORMATION**
103 **REGARDING OFFENDERS.**

Bill Summary

(Note: This summary applies to this bill as introduced and does not necessarily reflect any amendments that may be subsequently adopted.)

Allows the probation department in each judicial district to use state general fund moneys, if appropriated, to notify the victim of certain information regarding the offender.

1 *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado:*

1 **SECTION 1. Repeal.** 24-4.1-303 (13.5) (b), Colorado Revised
2 Statutes, is repealed as follows:

3 **24-4.1-303. Procedures for assuring rights of victims of crimes.**
4 (13.5) (b) ~~No state general fund moneys shall be used to pay any costs~~
5 ~~associated with the notifications required by this subsection (13.5).~~

6 **SECTION 2. Safety clause.** The general assembly hereby finds,
7 determines, and declares that this act is necessary for the immediate
8 preservation of the public peace, health, and safety.
