A BILL FOR AN ACT

101 **CONCERNING THE REMOVAL OF ALLENSPARK FROM THE REGIONAL**
102 **TRANSPORTATION DISTRICT.**

Bill Summary

(Note: This summary applies to this bill as introduced and does not necessarily reflect any amendments that may be subsequently adopted.)

Removes from the regional transportation district that portion of Boulder county that is within the boundaries of the Allenspark water and sanitation district.

2 **SECTION 1.** 32-9-106 (1), Colorado Revised Statutes, is

2 **32-9-106. District area.** (1) The area comprising the district shall
3 consist of that part of Adams county excluding census enumeration
4 districts 1, 2, and 3 of the east Adams division, as the districts and
5 division are used by the United States bureau of the census in designation
6 of land areas for purposes of the 1970 census and those parts of Adams
7 county as provided by section 32-9-106.4, that part of Arapahoe county
8 excluding census enumeration districts 1, 2, and 3 of the east Arapahoe
9 division, except for those parts of enumeration district 3 as provided in
10 subsection (4) of this section, as the districts and division are used by the
11 United States bureau of the census in designation of land areas for the
12 purposes of the 1970 census, ~~and~~ the city and county of Denver, ~~and~~ the
13 ~~counties~~ COUNTY of Jefferson, ~~and~~ THAT PART OF Boulder COUNTY
14 EXCLUDING THE AREA WITHIN THE BOUNDARIES OF THE ALLENSPARK
15 WATER AND SANITATION DISTRICT AS OF AUGUST 8, 2001, those parts of
16 Douglas county as provided by subsection (2) of this section and section
17 32-9-106.3, areas annexed by municipalities as provided by section
18 32-9-106.6, and areas included pursuant to a petition or an election in
19 accordance with section 32-9-106.7.

20 **SECTION 2. Effective date - applicability.** (1) This act shall
21 take effect at 12:01 a.m. on the day following the expiration of the
22 ninety-day period after final adjournment of the general assembly that is
23 allowed for submitting a referendum petition pursuant to article V, section
24 1 (3) of the state constitution; except that, if a referendum petition is filed
25 against this act or an item, section, or part of this act within such period,
26 then the act, item, section, or part, if approved by the people, shall take
27 effect on the date of the official declaration of the vote thereon by

1 proclamation of the governor.

2 (2) For purposes of the sales tax levied under section
3 32-9-119 (2), Colorado Revised Statutes, the provisions of this act shall
4 apply to transactions entered into on or after September 1, 2001, unless a
5 referendum petition is filed during the ninety-day period after final
6 adjournment of the general assembly that is allowed for submitting a
7 referendum petition pursuant to article V, section 1 (3) of the state
8 constitution. If such a referendum petition is filed against this act or an
9 item, section, or part of this act within such period, then for purposes of
10 the sales tax the provisions of this act, if approved by the people, shall
11 apply to transactions entered into on or after the first day of the calendar
12 year quarter following the date of the official declaration of the vote
13 thereon by proclamation of the governor.

14 (3) For property tax years commencing on or after January 1, 2002,
15 the territory excluded from the regional transportation district by this act
16 shall not be subject to any property tax levied by the board for the
17 operating costs of the regional transportation district. For the purpose of
18 retiring the regional transportation district's outstanding indebtedness and
19 the interest thereon existing at the effective date of this act, the excluded
20 territory shall be obligated to the same extent as all other property within
21 the regional transportation district but only for that proportion of such
22 outstanding indebtedness and the interest thereon existing immediately
23 prior to the effective date of this act. In no event shall the territory
24 excluded from the regional transportation district become obligated for the
25 payment of any bonded indebtedness created after the effective date of
26 this act.
