CONCERNING NAMING A PORTION OF INTERSTATE 25.

WHEREAS, The Honorable Ronald Reagan was born on February 6, 1911, in Tampico, Illinois, to John Edward Reagan and Nelle Wilson Reagan; and

WHEREAS, Ronald Reagan served as Governor of the State of California from 1966 to 1974; and

WHEREAS, On November 4, 1980, Ronald Reagan was elected as the 40th President of the United States of America and served two terms of office ending in 1988; and

WHEREAS, Former President Reagan reached 90 years of age on February 6, 2001; and

WHEREAS, According to Policy 803.0 established by the Transportation Commission of the State of Colorado and the Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices, federal rule 2D-49, the General Assembly of Colorado by resolution may designate a component of the state highway system in honor of an individual; now, therefore,

Be It Resolved by the Senate of the Sixty-third General Assembly of the State of Colorado, the House of Representatives concurring herein:

(1) That a portion of Interstate 25, between the southern and northern borders of El Paso County, Colorado, be named Ronald Reagan Highway, in honor of President Reagan's service to the American people.

(2) That the Colorado Department of Transportation may accept and expend gifts, grants, donations, and federal funds for the purposes of the initial placement of signs to mark the designated section of Interstate 25 as Ronald Reagan Highway.

(3) That the Colorado Department of Transportation may explore a cooperative agreement with the Commissioners of El Paso County for the maintenance of the markings for the highway.

Be It Further Resolved, That copies of this resolution be sent to former President Ronald Reagan, the Transportation Commission of Colorado, the Colorado Department of Transportation, the El Paso County Board of Commissioners, the Governor of Colorado, and the Ronald Reagan Presidential Library.
