WHEREAS, The Pueblo South Colts were not only the surprise winners of the state championship, but also achieved a 23-4 record for the season; and

WHEREAS, The team was assisted in its efforts by trainer Leanne Carabelos, volunteer coach Gregg Goddard, assistant coach Chuck Blagg, freshman coach D.J. Johnson, junior varsity coach Gary Pryor, and head coach Dave Lockett; and

WHEREAS, The team consisted of sophomore Kris Ducy; juniors Zach Brockman and Scott Law; and seniors Brad Baker, Chad Borgstedt, Ryan Daberkow, Jason Fearheileg, Ryan Goddard, Danny Medina, Daric Whilhite, and Danny Zufall; now, therefore,
