HOUSE JOINT RESOLUTION 01-1032

101 **CONCERNING COLORADO'S SUPPORT FOR THE MOVE OF THE BOEING**
102 **COMPANY'S WORLD HEADQUARTERS TO COLORADO.**

1 WHEREAS, The Boeing Company has been a world leader in
2 airline manufacturing and is ranked number one in the airline
3 manufacturing industry; and

4 WHEREAS, The Boeing Company has maintained its world
5 headquarters previously in Seattle, Washington, for 85 years; and

6 WHEREAS, The Boeing Company is aggressively restructuring
7 its business model to maintain its competitive edge in the current
8 worldwide airline manufacturing industry and enter new high-technology
9 industries; and

10 WHEREAS, The Boeing Company is considering moving its
11 worldwide headquarters to Colorado, bringing an estimated 500 corporate
12 executive jobs and creating approximately 2,700 ancillary jobs; and

13 WHEREAS, Such a relocation by the Boeing Company would
14 provide an additional \$50 million annual tax base for Colorado; and

1 WHEREAS, Colorado has been consistently ranked for the last 7
2 years as the best state for business by the Corporation for Enterprise
3 Development; and

4 WHEREAS, Colorado boasts the most highly educated workforce
5 in the nation with 34.6% of the state's residents holding college degrees;
6 and

7 WHEREAS, The Denver metropolitan area was recently named as
8 the number one place to raise children according to Child magazine; and

9 WHEREAS, Colorado has the best overall outdoor recreation
10 activities that provide the greatest "life balance"; and

11 WHEREAS, The state of Colorado is honored to be named one of
12 three potential destinations for the relocation of the Boeing Company's
13 world headquarters; now, therefore,

14 *Be It Resolved by the House of Representatives of the Sixty-third*
15 *General Assembly of the State of Colorado, the Senate concurring*
16 *herein:*

17 That the Colorado General Assembly hereby supports the move of
18 the Boeing Company's world headquarters to the state of Colorado.
