HOUSE JOINT RESOLUTION 01-1001

BY REPRESENTATIVES Spradley, Dean, and Grossman;
also SENATORS Thiebaut, Matsunaka, and Andrews.

CONCERNING A JOINT SESSION OF THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES AND THE SENATE OF THE SIXTY-THIRD GENERAL ASSEMBLY FOR THE PURPOSE OF CANVASSING THE VOTES FOR THE SECRETARY OF STATE AT THE ELECTION HELD NOVEMBER 7, 2000, AND APPOINTING TWO COMMITTEES TO ESCORT THE CHIEF JUSTICE AND THE SECRETARY OF STATE.

Be It Resolved by the House of Representatives of the Sixty-third General Assembly of the State of Colorado, the Senate concurring herein:

That a joint session of the House of Representatives and the Senate of the Sixty-third General Assembly be held in the House Chambers on January 10, 2001, at a time to be announced by both houses upon completion of organizational procedures, for the purpose of canvassing the votes for the Secretary of State at the election held November 7, 2000, and administering the oath of office for the Secretary of State.

Be It Further Resolved, That two committees be appointed, each consisting of two senators appointed by the President of the Senate and three representatives appointed by the Speaker of the House, one to escort the Chief Justice and the other to escort the Secretary of the State.
