A BILL FOR AN ACT

101 **CONCERNING MEMBERS OF THE STATE BOARD FOR COMMUNITY**
102 **COLLEGES AND OCCUPATIONAL EDUCATION.**

Bill Summary

(Note: This summary applies to this bill as introduced and does not necessarily reflect any amendments that may be subsequently adopted.)

Specifies that the student and faculty members of the state board for community colleges and occupational education are voting members of the board and have the right to attend executive sessions. Specifies that the student member of the board shall be elected by the state student advisory council.

1 *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado:*

2 **SECTION 1.** 23-60-104 (2) (a) (II), Colorado Revised Statutes,
3 is amended to read:

4 **23-60-104. State board for community colleges and**
5 **occupational education - student advisory council - state advisory**
6 **council.** (2) (a) (II) The tenth member shall be a student at a college of
7 a state system of community colleges, and the eleventh member shall be
8 a member of the faculty of a college of the state system of community
9 colleges. ~~Such members~~ THE FACULTY MEMBER OF THE BOARD shall be
10 elected in accordance with procedures established by the board, which
11 procedures shall take into account all the colleges within the state system
12 of community colleges. THE STUDENT MEMBER OF THE BOARD SHALL BE
13 ELECTED BY THE STATE STUDENT ADVISORY COUNCIL, AND SHALL BE
14 REQUIRED TO MAINTAIN GOOD STANDING AS A MEMBER OF THE COUNCIL.
15 The term of said offices shall be one year. Said offices shall ~~be advisory,~~
16 ~~without the right to vote, and~~ HAVE THE RIGHT TO VOTE AND shall ~~be~~
17 ~~without~~ HAVE the right to attend executive sessions.

18 **SECTION 2. Effective date.** This act shall take effect at 12:01
19 a.m. on the day following the expiration of the ninety-day period after
20 final adjournment of the general assembly that is allowed for submitting
21 a referendum petition pursuant to article V, section 1 (3) of the state
22 constitution; except that, if a referendum petition is filed against this act
23 or an item, section, or part of this act within such period, then the act,
24 item, section, or part, if approved by the people, shall take effect on the
25 date of the official declaration of the vote thereon by proclamation of the
26 governor.
