HOUSE BILL 01-1055

CONCERNING A REQUIREMENT THAT TITLE INSURANCE COMPANIES FILE FEES
WITH THE COMMISSIONER OF INSURANCE.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado:

SECTION 1. 10-11-118 (2) (b), Colorado Revised Statutes, is amended to read:

10-11-118. Title insurance. (2) (b) Prior to the effective date of any new or amended rate or fee, every title insurance company and title insurance agent shall file with the commissioner such new or amended rate OR FEE. Such filing shall not include the information or supporting documentation described in paragraph (a) of this subsection (2). Every title insurance company and title insurance agent shall make available upon request to the commissioner the statement of compliance and all information or supporting documentation referred to in paragraph (a) of this subsection (2).

SECTION 2. Safety clause. The general assembly hereby finds,
