**HOUSE JOINT RESOLUTION 01-1013**

101     **CONCERNING THE DESIGNATION OF THE BRIDGE ON STATE HIGHWAY**  
102             **133 CROSSING THE ROARING FORK RIVER IN CARBONDALE,**  
103             **COLORADO, AS THE "VETERANS' MEMORIAL BRIDGE".**

1             WHEREAS, Many Colorado men and women are deserving of  
2 high respect and honor for their service in the military forces of our  
3 country, especially those who have sacrificed their lives or have suffered  
4 physical or emotional injuries; and

5             WHEREAS, Interest has been growing in expressing the  
6 appreciation and esteem felt by the American people for its veterans of  
7 armed conflicts who have demonstrated throughout our country's history  
8 loyalty and dedication to their nation; and

9             WHEREAS, The bridge on state highway 133 crossing the Roaring  
10 Fork River in Carbondale, Colorado, serves a prominent part in the annual  
11 Memorial Day observances in Carbondale; and

12            WHEREAS, Designating the bridge as the "Veterans' Memorial

1 Bridge" has the full support of Randy Vanderhurst, mayor of Carbondale;  
2 the Carbondale Board of Trustees; and the honorable Russell George,  
3 director of the Colorado Division of Wildlife and former Speaker of the  
4 Colorado House of Representatives; now, therefore,

5 *Be It Resolved by the House of Representatives of the Sixty-third*  
6 *General Assembly of the State of Colorado, the Senate concurring herein:*

7 That we, the members of the First Regular Session of the  
8 Sixty-third General Assembly, on behalf of the citizens of this state,  
9 hereby urge the state Transportation Commission to designate the bridge  
10 on state highway 133 crossing the Roaring Fork River in Carbondale,  
11 Colorado, as "Veterans' Memorial Bridge" to honor all veterans.

12 *Be It Further Resolved,* That copies of this Joint Resolution be  
13 transmitted to the state Transportation Commission; Thomas E. Norton,  
14 Executive Director of the Colorado Department of Transportation; and  
15 Mr. Ronald W. Borski of Grand Junction, Colorado, veterans' advocate.
