HOUSE BILL 01-1021

BY REPRESENTATIVE(S) Tochtrop, Borodkin, Coleman, Grossman, Mace, Madden, Marshall, Ragsdale, Tapia, Vigil, and Williams S.; also SENATOR(S) Tate.

CONCERNING INCREASED DISCLOSURE REQUIREMENTS RELATING TO THE PROVISION OF AUTOMOBILE PERSONAL INJURY PROTECTION INSURANCE.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado:

SECTION 1. 10-4-706 (2) (g), Colorado Revised Statutes, is amended to read:

10-4-706. Required coverages - complying policies - PIP examination program - repeal. (2) (g) (I) The commissioner shall have the authority to promulgate rules necessary to implement the requirements of this section.

(II) ON OR BEFORE DECEMBER 31, 2001, THE COMMISSIONER SHALL HOLD A RULE-MAKING HEARING REGARDING THE DISCLOSURE REQUIREMENTS CONTAINED IN THIS SUBSECTION (2).
