HOUSE BILL 01-1398

BY REPRESENTATIVE(S) Clapp, Boyd, Coleman, Hoppe, Mace, Miller, Mitchell, Sanchez, Scott, Swenson, Veiga, Weddig, and Williams S.; also SENATOR(S) Phillips.

CONCERNING LEGISLATIVE APPROVAL OF AIR QUALITY IMPROVEMENT STRATEGIES NECESSARY FOR THE REDESIGNATION OF THE DENVER REGION TO ATTAINMENT STATUS FOR COMPLIANCE WITH FEDERAL AIR QUALITY STANDARDS, AND, IN CONNECTION THEREWITH, APPROVING THE DENVER ELEMENT OF THE PM-10 STATE IMPLEMENTATION PLAN.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado:

SECTION 1. 25-7-133.5, Colorado Revised Statutes, is amended BY THE ADDITION OF A NEW SUBSECTION to read:

25-7-133.5. Extension or rescission of specific revisions to the state implementation plan (SIP) after 1996. (6) NOTWITHSTANDING THE PROVISIONS OF SECTION 25-7-133, REVISIONS TO THE DENVER METROPOLITAN AREA ELEMENT OF THE PM-10 STATE IMPLEMENTATION PLAN ADOPTED BY THE COMMISSION ON APRIL 19, 2001, ARE APPROVED FOR INCORPORATION INTO THE STATE IMPLEMENTATION PLAN, SHALL BE SUBMITTED TO THE FEDERAL ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION AGENCY AS EXPEDITIOUSLY AS POSSIBLE, AND SHALL NOT BE SUBJECT TO FURTHER

SECTION 2. Safety clause. The general assembly hereby finds, determines, and declares that this act is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, and safety.
