**Bill Summary**

Clarifies that the term "raffle" includes the game commonly referred to as a "duck race" for purposes of the "Bingo and Raffles Law".  
Defines "duck race".

1 *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado:*

2 **SECTION 1.** 12-9-102 (19.3), Colorado Revised Statutes, is  
3 amended, and the said 12-9-102 is further amended BY THE ADDITION  
4 OF A NEW SUBSECTION, to read:

5 **12-9-102. Definitions.** As used in this article, unless the context  
6 otherwise requires:

7 (2.7) "DUCK RACE" MEANS A GAME IN WHICH A PARTICIPANT BUYS  
8 A TICKET FOR A CHANCE AT A PRIZE WITH THE WINNER DETERMINED BY  
9 IDENTICAL OBJECTS, USUALLY SHAPED LIKE DUCKS, SIMULTANEOUSLY  
10 PLACED IN A STREAM, RIVER, CANAL, OR OTHER FLOWING BODY OF WATER,  
11 THAT CROSS RANDOMLY OVER A DESIGNATED FINISH LINE. SUCH GAME  
12 SHALL TAKE PLACE AT A SET LOCATION AND DATE.

13 (19.3) "Raffle" means a game in which a participant buys a ticket  
14 for a chance at a prize with the winner determined by a random drawing  
15 to take place at a set location and date or a pull tab ticket as described in  
16 subsection (18.1) of this section. THE TERM "RAFFLE" INCLUDES THE  
17 GAME COMMONLY REFERRED TO AS A DUCK RACE AS DESCRIBED IN  
18 SUBSECTION (2.7) OF THIS SECTION. The term "raffle" does not mean and  
19 shall not be interpreted to include any activity that is authorized or  
20 regulated by the state lottery division pursuant to part 2 of article 35 of  
21 title 24, C.R.S., or the "Limited Gaming Act of 1991", article 47.1 of this  
22 title.

23 **SECTION 2. Appropriation.** In addition to any other  
24 appropriation, there is hereby appropriated, out of any moneys in the  
25 bingo-raffle cash fund created in section 12-9-103.5, Colorado Revised  
26 Statutes, not otherwise appropriated, to the department of state, for the  
27 fiscal year beginning July 1, 2001, the sum of four thousand sixty-five

1 dollars (\$4,065), or so much thereof as may be necessary, for the  
2 implementation of this act.

3 **SECTION 3. Safety clause.** The general assembly hereby finds,  
4 determines, and declares that this act is necessary for the immediate  
5 preservation of the public peace, health, and safety.
