After consideration on the merits, the Committee recommends the following:

SB01-160 be amended as follows, and as so amended, be referred to the Committee of the Whole with favorable recommendation:

- 1 Amend printed bill, page 2, line 4, after "OWNER", insert "OR
- 2 CUSTODIAN";
- 3 line 5, strike "NEGLIGENTLY" and substitute "THROUGH AN ACT OF
- 4 CRIMINAL NEGLIGENCE, AS DEFINED BY SECTION 18-1-501(3),";
- 5 line 6, strike "JUVENILE" and substitute "PERSON UNDER THE AGE OF
- 6 EIGHTEEN YEARS";
- 7 line 7, after "THEN", insert "UNLAWFULLY";
- 8 strike lines 12 through 15.
- 9 Renumber succeeding subsections accordingly.
- 10 Page 2, line 17, strike "JUVENILE" and substitute "PERSON UNDER THE AGE
- 11 OF EIGHTEEN YEARS";
- 12 line 19, strike "JUVENILE'S" and substitute "PERSON'S UNDER THE AGE OF
- 13 EIGHTEEN YEARS";
- 14 line 21, strike "SELF-DEFENSE;" and substitute "SELF-DEFENSE OR DEFENSE
- 15 OF ANOTHER;"
- 16 line 22, strike "HOME" and substitute "RESIDENCE".

1 Page 3, strike lines 3 through 7 and substitute the following:

2 "(e) WHILE PRACTICING THE USE OF A FIREARM OR TARGET
3 SHOOTING AT AN ESTABLISHED RANGE AUTHORIZED BY THE GOVERNING
4 BODY OF THE JURISDICTION IN WHICH SUCH RANGE IS LOCATED OR ANY
5 OTHER AREA WHERE THE DISCHARGE OF A FIREARM IS NOT PROHIBITED;

6 (f) WHILE HUNTING OR TRAPPING PURSUANT TO A VALID LICENSE
7 ISSUED TO SUCH PERSON PURSUANT TO ARTICLE 4 OF TITLE 33, C.R.S.;

8 (g) WHILE ENGAGING IN AN ORGANIZED COMPETITION INVOLVING
9 THE USE OF A FIREARM OR PARTICIPATING IN OR PRACTICING FOR A
10 PERFORMANCE BY AN ORGANIZED GROUP UNDER 501 (c) (3) AS
11 DETERMINED BY THE FEDERAL INTERNAL REVENUE SERVICE WHICH USES
12 FIREARMS AS PART OF SUCH PERFORMANCE;

13 (h) WHILE TRAVELING WITH ANY FIREARM IN SUCH PERSON'S
14 POSSESSION BEING UNLOADED TO OR FROM ANY ACTIVITY DESCRIBED IN
15 PARAGRAPH (a), (d), (e), (f), OR (g) OF THIS SUBSECTION (2); OR

16 (i) THROUGH THE COMMISSION OF ROBBERY, AS DEFINED BY
17 SECTION 18-4-301 OR SECTION 18-4-302; OR BURGLARY, AS DEFINED BY
18 SECTIONS 18-4-202, 18-4-203, AND 18-4-204."
