Committee on Criminal Justice.

After consideration on the merits, the Committee recommends the following:

SB01-032 be amended as follows, and as so amended, be referred to the Committee on Appropriations with favorable recommendation:

1 Amend reengrossed bill, page 5, strike lines 13 through 19 and substitute  
2 the following:

3 "WITHIN TWENTY-FOUR HOURS AFTER THE RECEIPT OF:

4 (I) AN ELECTRONIC VERSION OF THE SUSPECT'S ARREST AND  
5 FINGERPRINT INFORMATION BY THE BUREAU; OR

6 (II) A PAPER COPY OF THE SUSPECT'S ARREST AND FINGERPRINT  
7 INFORMATION BY THE BUREAU IF THE INFORMATION IS FROM A  
8 JURISDICTION THAT DOES NOT USE AN ELECTRONICALLY-BASED  
9 FINGERPRINT TRANSMISSION SYSTEM."

10 Page 7, line 9, after "a", insert "FINGERPRINT-BASED";

11 line 10, after "~~record~~", insert "HISTORY";

12 line 14, after "criminal", insert "HISTORY".

13 Page 8, strike line 2 and substitute the following:

1 "THIS SUBPARAGRAPH (I) shall require the FINGERPRINT-BASED criminal  
2 HISTORY background check in all";

3 strike line 5 and substitute the following:

4 "~~fingerpr~~ FINGERPRINT-BASED CRIMINAL HISTORY BACKGROUND check  
5 through the Colorado bureau of investigation, EXCEPT FOR PERSONS  
6 RESIDING IN THIS STATE LESS THAN TWO YEARS WHO SHALL BE REQUIRED  
7 TO HAVE A FEDERAL BUREAU OF INVESTIGATION FINGERPRINT-BASED  
8 CRIMINAL HISTORY BACKGROUND CHECK THROUGH THE COLORADO  
9 BUREAU OF INVESTIGATION. As part";

10 strike lines 18 through 27 and substitute the following:

11 "(I.5) RULES PROMULGATED BY THE STATE BOARD PURSUANT TO  
12 SUBPARAGRAPH (I) OF THIS PARAGRAPH (a) SHALL ALSO INCLUDE:".

13 Page 9, line 1, strike "(B)" and substitute "(A)";

14 line 9, strike "(C)" and substitute "(B)";

15 strike lines 23 through 27 and substitute the following:

16 "**SECTION 10. Appropriation.** In addition to any other  
17 appropriation, there is hereby appropriated out of the general fund, to the  
18 department of human services, division of child care, child care assistance  
19 program, for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2001, the sum of \_\_\_\_\_  
20 dollars (\$ ), or so much thereof as may be necessary, for the  
21 implementation of this act. In addition to said appropriation, the general  
22 assembly anticipates that, for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2001, the  
23 department of human services, division of child care, child care assistance  
24 program, will receive the sum of sixty-three thousand one hundred  
25 seventy-eight dollars (\$63,178) for the implementation of this act.  
26 Although the federal funds are not appropriated in this act, they are noted  
27 for the purpose of indicating the assumptions used relative to these funds  
28 in developing the state appropriation amounts, or so much thereof as may  
29 be necessary, for the implementation of this act.

1           **SECTION 11. Effective date.** This act shall take effect July 1,  
2 2001, but only if Senate Bill 01-077, enacted at the First Regular Session  
3 of the Sixty-third General Assembly, becomes law."
