Committee on Appropriations.

After consideration on the merits, the Committee recommends the following:

SB01-032 be amended as follows, and as so amended, be referred to the Committee of the Whole with favorable recommendation:

1 Amend Criminal Justice Committee Report, dated April 26, 2001, page
2 2, strike lines 16 through 29 and substitute the following:

3 **""SECTION 10. Appropriation.** (1) In addition to any other
4 appropriation, there is hereby appropriated, for the fiscal year beginning
5 July 1, 2001, to the department of human services, division of child care,
6 for child care licensing and administration, the sum of ninety-five
7 thousand six hundred fifty-eight dollars (\$95,658) and 2.5 FTE, or so
8 much thereof is necessary for implementation of this act. Of said sum,
9 nineteen thousand one hundred thirty-two dollars (\$19,132) shall be from
10 the general fund, and seventy-six thousand five hundred twenty-six
11 dollars (\$76,526) shall be from federal child care development funds.

12 (2) In addition to any other appropriation, there is hereby
13 appropriated, for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2001, to the department
14 of public safety, Colorado bureau of investigation, the sum of three
15 hundred twenty-three thousand two hundred thirty-eight dollars
16 (\$323,238) and 1.5 FTE, or so much thereof is necessary for
17 implementation of this act. Of said sum, two hundred forty-eight
18 thousand nine hundred eighty-eight dollars (\$248,988) shall be from cash
19 funds from fingerprint and name check processing fees, and seventy-four

1 thousand two hundred and fifty dollars (\$74,250) shall be from cash
2 funds exempt.

3 (3) It is the intent of the general assembly that the general fund
4 appropriation in subsection (1) of this section for the implementation of
5 this act shall be derived from savings generated from the implementation
6 of the provisions of S.B. 01-77, as enacted during the first regular session
7 of the sixty-third general assembly.

8 **SECTION 11. Effective date.** (1) This act shall take effect upon
9 the passage.

10 (2) Notwithstanding the provisions of subsection (1) of this
11 section, this act shall only take effect if:

12 (a) The final fiscal estimate for S.B. 01-77, as reflected in the
13 appropriations clause for said act, shows a net general fund savings that
14 is equal to or greater than the final general fund fiscal estimate for this
15 act, as reflected in section 10 of this act; and

16 (b) S.B. 01-77 is enacted at the first regular session of the sixty-
17 third general assembly and becomes law."."
