- 8 **24-72.4-102. Definitions.** AS USED IN THIS ARTICLE, UNLESS THE 9 CONTEXT OTHERWISE REQUIRES:
- 10 (1) "CHIEF INFORMATION OFFICER" MEANS THE CHIEF 11 INFORMATION OFFICER APPOINTED PURSUANT TO SECTION 24-37.5-103.
- 12 (2) "Web-based system" means the searchable web-based system that provides access to descriptions of revenues and expenditures recorded in the state's official book of record that, in accordance with executive order 007-09, is developed and maintained by the chief information officer, in consultation with the state controller.

 THAN JANUARY 1, 2010, THE CHIEF INFORMATION OFFICER SHALL MODIFY
 THE WEB-BASED SYSTEM TO MEET THE FOLLOWING REQUIREMENTS:

This act 12 shall take effect at 12:01 a.m. on the day following the expiration of the 13 ninety-day period after final adjournment of the general assembly that is 14 allowed for submitting a referendum petition pursuant to article V, section 1 (3) of the state constitution, (August 4, 2009, if adjournment 15 16 sine die is on May 6, 2009); except that, if a referendum petition is filed 17 against this act or an item, section, or part of this act within such period, then the act, item, section, or part, if approved by the people, shall take 18 19 effect on the date of the official declaration of the vote thereon by 20 proclamation of the governor.".
