8	this subsection (3.5) may cast such ballot by mail. and the ballot shall be
9	treated as a provisional ballot in accordance with the requirements of
10	article 8.5 of this title. The designated election official shall,
11	WITHIN THREE DAYS AFTER THE RECEIPT OF A MAIL BALLOT THAT DOES
12	NOT CONTAIN A COPY OF IDENTIFICATION AS DEFINED IN SECTION 1-1-104
13	(19.5), BUT IN NO EVENT LATER THAN TWO DAYS AFTER ELECTION DAY,
14	SEND TO THE ELIGIBLE ELECTOR AT THE ADDRESS INDICATED IN THE
15	REGISTRATION RECORDS A LETTER EXPLAINING THE LACK OF COMPLIANCE
16	WITH PARAGRAPH (b) OF THIS SUBSECTION (3.5). IF THE DESIGNATED
17	ELECTION OFFICIAL RECEIVES A COPY OF IDENTIFICATION IN COMPLIANCE
18	WITH PARAGRAPH (b) OF THIS SUBSECTION (3.5) WITHIN EIGHT DAYS AFTER
19	ELECTION DAY, AND IF THE MAIL BALLOT IS OTHERWISE VALID, THE MAIL
20	BALLOT SHALL BE COUNTED.".
