- Amend printed bill, page 4, line 25, after "(2),", insert "(4),".
- 2 Page 8, after line 4, insert the following:
- 3 "(4) When the director is satisfied that further efforts to settle the 4 matter by conference, conciliation, and persuasion will be futile, he OR 5 SHE shall so report to the commission. If the commission determines that 6 the circumstances warrant, it shall issue and cause to be served, in the 7 manner provided by section 24-4-105 (2), a written notice and complaint 8 requiring the respondent to answer the charges at a formal hearing before 9 the commission, a commissioner, or an administrative law judge; EXCEPT 10 THAT IN CASES WHERE THE CHARGING PARTY HAS ASSERTED A CLAIM 11 THAT COULD NOT BE BROUGHT UNDER TITLE VII OF THE FEDERAL "CIVIL 12 RIGHTS ACT OF 1964", AS AMENDED, THE FEDERAL "AMERICANS WITH 13 DISABILITIES ACT OF 1990", AS AMENDED, 42 U.S.C. SEC. 12101 ET SEQ., 14 OR THE FEDERAL "AGE DISCRIMINATION IN EMPLOYMENT ACT OF 1967", 15 AS AMENDED, 29 U.S.C. SEC. 621 ET SEQ., THE CHARGING PARTY, UPON 16 REQUEST, SHALL BE ENTITLED TO A FORMAL HEARING BEFORE THE 17 COMMISSION OR AN ADMINISTRATIVE LAW JUDGE AS SPECIFIED IN THIS 18 SUBSECTION (4), AND THE CHARGING PARTY SHALL BE ENTITLED TO 19 REPRESENTATION AT THE HEARING BY AN ATTORNEY FROM THE ATTORNEY 20 GENERAL'S OFFICE. Such hearing shall be commenced within one hundred 21 twenty days after the service of such written notice and complaint. Such 22 notice and complaint shall state the time, place, and nature of the hearing, 23 the legal authority and jurisdiction under which it is to be held, and the 24 matters of fact and law asserted.".
