- 5 "THE QUALIFYING RETAIL UTILITY MAY ESTABLISH ONE OR MORE
- 6 STANDARD OFFERS TO PURCHASE RENEWABLE ENERGY CREDITS
- 7 GENERATED FROM THE ELIGIBLE SOLAR ELECTRIC GENERATION ON THE
- 8 CUSTOMER'S PREMISES SO LONG AS THE GENERATION MEETS THE SIZE AND
- 9 LOCATION REQUIREMENTS SET FORTH IN SUBPARAGRAPH (II) OF THIS
- 10 PARAGRAPH (e) AND SO LONG AS THE GENERATION IS FIVE HUNDRED
- 11 KILOWATTS OR LESS IN SIZE. WHEN ESTABLISHING THE STANDARD OFFERS,
- 12 THE PRICES FOR RENEWABLE ENERGY CREDITS SHOULD BE SET AT LEVELS
- 13 SUFFICIENT TO ENCOURAGE INCREASED CUSTOMER-SITED SOLAR
- 14 GENERATION IN THE SIZE RANGES COVERED BY EACH STANDARD OFFER,
- 15 BUT AT LEVELS THAT WILL STILL ALLOW THE QUALIFYING RETAIL UTILITY
- 16 TO COMPLY WITH THE ELECTRIC RESOURCE STANDARDS SET FORTH IN
- 17 PARAGRAPH (c) OF THIS SUBSECTION (1) WITHOUT EXCEEDING THE RETAIL
- 18 RATE IMPACT LIMIT IN PARAGRAPH (g) OF THIS SUBSECTION (1).".
