After consideration on the merits, the Committee recommends the following:

SB09-228 be amended as follows:

1 Amend reengrossed bill, strike everything below the enacting clause and
2 substitute the following:

3 "SECTION 1. 24-75-201.1 (1) (a) (II) (B), Colorado Revised
4 Statutes, is amended to read:

5 **24-75-201.1. Restriction on state appropriations - legislative**
6 **declaration - definitions.** (1) (a) (II) Except as otherwise provided for
7 in subparagraphs (III) and (IV) of this paragraph (a), for the fiscal year
8 1991-92 and each fiscal year thereafter, the total state general fund
9 appropriations shall be limited to such moneys as are necessary for
10 reappraisals of any class or classes of taxable property for property tax
11 purposes as required by section 39-1-105.5, C.R.S., plus the lesser of:

12 (B) Six percent over the HIGHEST total state general fund
13 appropriations for ~~the~~ ANY previous fiscal year BEGINNING WITH THE
14 FISCAL YEAR 2007-08.

15 **SECTION 2. Act subject to petition - effective date.** This act
16 shall take effect at 12:01 a.m. on the day following the expiration of the
17 ninety-day period after final adjournment of the general assembly that is
18 allowed for submitting a referendum petition pursuant to article V,
19 section 1 (3) of the state constitution, (August 5, 2009, if adjournment
20 sine die is on May 6, 2009); except that, if a referendum petition is filed
21 against this act or an item, section, or part of this act within such period,
22 then the act, item, section, or part, if approved by the people, shall take



1 effect on the date of the official declaration of the vote thereon by
2 proclamation of the governor."
