## SENATE COMMITTEE OF REFERENCE REPORT

After consideration on the merits, the Committee recommends the following:

SB09-256 be amended as follows:

1 Amend printed bill, page 6, strike lines 3 through 27.

2 Page 7, strike lines 1 through 9 and substitute the following:

3 "SECTION 4. 22-54-104 (2) (b) (II) (A), (4), and (5) (f),  
4 Colorado Revised Statutes, are amended to read:

5 **22-54-104. District total program.** (2) (b) If the district  
6 percentage of at-risk pupils is greater than the statewide average  
7 percentage of at-risk pupils and the district's funded pupil count is greater  
8 than four hundred fifty-nine, the district's total program shall be the lesser  
9 of:

10 (II) (A) The district's total program as calculated by: Adding the  
11 amount determined by multiplying the district's per pupil funding by four  
12 hundred fifty-nine to the amount determined by multiplying ~~12%~~ 11.9%  
13 of the district's per pupil funding by the district's at-risk pupils; then  
14 dividing the sum of those two amounts by four hundred fifty-nine; then  
15 multiplying the resulting amount by the district's funded pupil count  
16 minus the district's on-line pupil enrollment; and then adding the district's  
17 on-line funding.

18 (4) A district's at-risk funding shall be determined in accordance  
19 with one of the following formulas:

20 (a) (I) If the district percentage of at-risk pupils is equal to or less



1 than the statewide average percentage of at-risk pupils or the district's  
2 funded pupil count is equal to or less than four hundred fifty-nine, the  
3 formula shall be:

4 (District per pupil funding x ~~12%~~ 11.9%) x District at-risk  
5 pupils

6 (II) Repealed.

7 (b) (I) If the district percentage of at-risk pupils is greater than the  
8 statewide average percentage of at-risk pupils and the district's funded  
9 pupil count is greater than four hundred fifty-nine, the formula shall be:  
10 ((District per pupil funding x ~~12%~~ 11.9%) x (Statewide average  
11 percentage of at-risk pupils x District pupil enrollment)) + ((District per  
12 pupil funding x District at-risk factor) x (District at-risk pupils -  
13 (Statewide average percentage of at-risk pupils x District pupil  
14 enrollment)))

15 (II) Repealed.

16 (5) For purposes of the formulas used in this section:

17 (f) (I) If the district percentage of at-risk pupils is greater than the  
18 statewide average percentage of at-risk pupils and the district's funded  
19 pupil count is greater than four hundred fifty-nine but not in excess of  
20 fifty thousand, the district's at-risk factor shall be ~~12%~~ 11.9% plus a 0.30  
21 percentage point for each percentage point that the district percentage of  
22 at-risk pupils exceeds the statewide average percentage of at-risk pupils;  
23 except that no district's at-risk factor shall exceed 30%.

24 (II) If the district percentage of at-risk pupils is greater than the  
25 statewide average percentage of at-risk pupils and the district's funded  
26 pupil count is greater than fifty thousand, the district's at-risk factor shall  
27 be ~~12%~~ 11.9% plus a 0.36 percentage point for each percentage point that  
28 the district percentage of at-risk pupils exceeds the statewide average  
29 percentage of at-risk pupils; except that no district's at-risk factor shall  
30 exceed 30%."

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
