HB09-1118 be amended as follows:

1 Amend printed bill, page 7, after line 12, insert the following:

2 "SECTION 12. 40-6-109 (1), Colorado Revised Statutes, is
3 amended to read:

4 **40-6-109. Hearings - orders - record - review - representation**
5 **of entities in nonadjudicatory proceedings.** (1) At the time fixed for
6 any hearing before the commission, any commissioner, or an
7 administrative law judge, or, at the time to which the same may have been
8 continued, the applicant, petitioner, complainant, the person, firm, or
9 corporation complained of, and such persons, firms, or corporations as the
10 commission may allow to intervene and such persons, firms, or
11 corporations as will be interested in or affected by any order that may be
12 made by the commission in such proceeding and who shall have become
13 parties to the proceeding shall be entitled to be heard, examine and
14 cross-examine witnesses, and introduce evidence. A full and complete
15 record of all proceedings had before the commission, any commissioner,
16 or an administrative law judge in any formal hearing, ~~had,~~ and all
17 testimony, shall be taken down by any reporter appointed by the
18 commission ~~and~~ OR, AS DEEMED APPROPRIATE BY THE COMMISSION, A
19 COMMISSIONER, OR AN ADMINISTRATIVE LAW JUDGE, AS APPLICABLE,
20 RECORDED ELECTRONICALLY. All parties in interest shall be entitled to be
21 heard in person or by attorney."
