1-8-111. Delivery of mail-in ballots and replacement mail-in ballots. (1) The mail-in ballot and other materials shall be delivered of mailed to the elector within seventy-two hours after the receipt of the application, if the official ballots are then printed, or, if not then printed within seventy-two hours after the printed ballots are delivered to the designated election official, but no sooner than twenty-two days before every odd-year, congressional vacancy, primary, and general election. If the mail-in ballot and other materials are mailed, the envelope shall be marked "DO NOT FORWARD" or by any other similar statement that it in accordance with United States postal service regulations. EXCEPT A OTHERWISE PROVIDED IN PARAGRAPH (b) OF THIS SUBSECTION (1), nothing in this subsection (1) shall affect any provision of this code governing the delivery of mail or mail-in ballots to an absent uniformed services elector nonresident overseas elector, or resident overseas elector covered by the federal "Uniformed and Overseas Citizens Absentee Voting Act", 4 U.S.C. sec. 1973ff ET SEQ.".
