After consideration on the merits, the Committee recommends the following:

SB09-292 be amended as follows:

1 Amend reengrossed bill, page 89, above line 13, insert the following:

2 "SECTION 137. 1-8-111 (1), Colorado Revised Statutes, as
3 amended by section 3 of the reengrossed version of House Bill 09-1337,
4 is amended to read:

5 **1-8-111. Delivery of mail-in ballots and replacement mail-in**
6 **ballots.** (1) The mail-in ballot and other materials shall be delivered or
7 mailed to the elector within seventy-two hours after the receipt of the
8 application, if the official ballots are then printed, or, if not then printed,
9 within seventy-two hours after the printed ballots are delivered to the
10 designated election official, but no sooner than twenty-two days before
11 every odd-year, congressional vacancy, primary, and general election. If
12 the mail-in ballot and other materials are mailed, the envelope shall be
13 marked "DO NOT FORWARD" or by any other similar statement that is
14 in accordance with United States postal service regulations. EXCEPT AS
15 OTHERWISE PROVIDED IN PARAGRAPH (b) OF THIS SUBSECTION (1), nothing
16 in this subsection (1) shall affect any provision of this code governing the
17 delivery of mail or mail-in ballots to an absent uniformed services elector,
18 nonresident overseas elector, or resident overseas elector covered by the
19 federal "Uniformed and Overseas Citizens Absentee Voting Act", 42
20 U.S.C. sec. 1973ff ET SEQ."

21 Renumber succeeding section accordingly.

22 Page 89, after line 24, add:

23 "(f) Section 137 of this act shall take effect only if both House Bill
24 09-1205 and House Bill 09-1337 are enacted and become law."
