## SENATE COMMITTEE OF REFERENCE REPORT

After consideration on the merits, the Committee recommends the following:

HB09-1089 be amended as follows:

1 Amend reengrossed bill, page 6, strike lines 11 and 12 and substitute the  
2 following:

3 "except in the case of trailer coaches; truck tractors; MULTIPURPOSE  
4 TRAILERS, IF KNOWN WHEN FILED; and motor homes, ~~which~~ THAT are  
5 subject to the provisions of".

6 Page 7, strike lines 6 and 7 and substitute the following:

7 "~~same as in other cases.~~ If any mortgage other than one on a trailer  
8 coach; truck tractor; MULTIPURPOSE TRAILER, IF KNOWN WHEN FILED; or  
9 motor home, ~~which~~ THAT has".

10 Page 9, strike lines 8 through 19 and substitute the following:

11 **"SECTION 8. Act subject to petition - effective date -**  
12 **applicability.** (1) This act shall take effect October 1, 2009.

13 (2) However, if a referendum petition is filed against this act or  
14 an item, section, or part of this act during the ninety-day period after final  
15 adjournment of the general assembly that is allowed for submitting a  
16 referendum petition pursuant to article V, section 1 (3) of the state  
17 constitution, then the act, item, section, or part, shall not take effect unless  
18 approved by the people at a biennial regular general election and shall  
19 take effect on the date specified in subsection (1) or on the date of the  
20 official declaration of the vote thereon by proclamation of the governor,



1 whichever is later.

2 (3) The provisions of this act shall apply to applications or filings  
3 made on or after the applicable effective date of this act."
