## S.B 09-115

## SUNSET RECOMENDTION OF PUBLIC LIVESTOCK MARKET

- 1. Continues the regulation of public livestock markets by the State Board of Stock Inspection.
- 2. Allows the Commissioner of Agriculture to set the expiration and renewal date by rule.

## Requirements

- Any person, partnership, or corporation wishing to establish and operate, a public livestock market within the state of Colorado may procure a license from the State Board of Stock Inspection
- The applicant files evidence of a surety bond approved by the state board of stock inspection commissioners in a penal sum of not less than twenty-five thousand dollars, and the Brand Commissioner named as trustee.
- Upon entering a public livestock market, livestock shall be inspected for iron brands, earmarks, and other identifying characteristics before being offered for sale. The public livestock market shall warrant to the purchaser the title of all livestock sold through his public livestock market.
