After consideration on the merits, the Committee recommends the following:

SB09-232 be amended as follows:

1 Amend printed bill, strike everything below the enacting clause and
2 substitute the following:

3 "SECTION 1. 34-63-102 (5.3) (a) (I), Colorado Revised Statutes,
4 is amended BY THE ADDITION OF A NEW SUB-SUBPARAGRAPH
5 to read:

6 **34-63-102. Creation of mineral leasing fund - distribution -**
7 **advisory committee - definitions.** (5.3) (a) Bonus payments credited to
8 the mineral leasing fund created in subparagraph (I) of paragraph (a) of
9 subsection (1) of this section shall be distributed on a quarterly basis for
10 each quarter commencing on July 1, October 1, January 1, or April 1 of
11 any state fiscal year as follows:

12 (I) (C) THE EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR OF THE DEPARTMENT OF LOCAL
13 AFFAIRS, OR HIS OR HER DESIGNEE; THE STATE TREASURER, OR HIS OR HER
14 DESIGNEE; THE DIRECTOR OF THE COLORADO OFFICE OF ECONOMIC
15 DEVELOPMENT, OR HIS OR HER DESIGNEE; AND THE MEMBERS OF THE
16 ENERGY IMPACT ASSISTANCE ADVISORY COMMITTEE CREATED IN SECTION
17 34-63-102 (5) (b) (I), C.R.S., THAT REPRESENT FEDERAL MINERAL LEASE
18 COMMUNITIES, SHALL WORK TOGETHER WITH THE EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR,
19 OR HIS OR HER DESIGNEE, OF THE COLORADO MUNICIPAL LEAGUE, OR ITS
20 SUCCESSOR ORGANIZATION; THE EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR, OR HIS OR HER
21 DESIGNEE, OF COLORADO COUNTIES, INCORPORATED, OR ITS SUCCESSOR
22 ORGANIZATION; REPRESENTATIVES OF THE ENERGY AND MINERAL
23 INDUSTRY OF FEDERAL MINERAL LEASE PRODUCING COUNTIES; AND ANY



1 OTHER STAKEHOLDERS TO EVALUATE THE PRIORITIES AND OPPORTUNITIES
2 ASSOCIATED WITH THE LOCAL GOVERNMENT PERMANENT FUND CREATED
3 IN SUB-SUBPARAGRAPH (A) OF THIS SUBPARAGRAPH (I), INCLUDING BUT
4 NOT LIMITED TO ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT, INFRASTRUCTURE,
5 COMMUNITY SUSTAINABILITY, LEVERAGING OPPORTUNITIES PRESENTED BY
6 THE "AMERICAN RECOVERY AND REINVESTMENT ACT OF 2009", PUB.L.
7 111-5, AND DISTRIBUTION OF THE LOCAL GOVERNMENT PERMANENT FUND.
8 THE GROUP SPECIFIED IN THIS SUB-SUBPARAGRAPH (C) SHALL
9 RECOMMEND ANY PROPOSED LEGISLATION TO THE LOCAL GOVERNMENT
10 AND ENERGY COMMITTEE OF THE SENATE AND THE LOCAL GOVERNMENT
11 COMMITTEE OF THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES, OR ANY SUCCESSOR
12 COMMITTEES, NO LATER THAN JANUARY 31, 2010.

13 **SECTION 2. Act subject to petition - effective date.** This act
14 shall take effect at 12:01 a.m. on the day following the expiration of the
15 ninety-day period after final adjournment of the general assembly that is
16 allowed for submitting a referendum petition pursuant to article V,
17 section 1 (3) of the state constitution, (August 5, 2009, if adjournment
18 sine die is on May 6, 2009); except that, if a referendum petition is filed
19 against this act or an item, section, or part of this act within such period,
20 then the act, item, section, or part, if approved by the people, shall take
21 effect on the date of the official declaration of the vote thereon by
22 proclamation of the governor."
