22	(1) No other provision of this part 2 and no provision of part 3 of this
23	article shall apply to bicycles A BICYCLE OR EPAMD or to equipment for
24	use on bicycles A BICYCLE OR EPAMD except those provisions in this
25	article made specifically applicable to bicyclists, bicycles, or their
26	equipment SUCH A VEHICLE.
27	(2) Every bicycle OR EPAMD in use at the times described in
28	section 42-4-204 shall be equipped with a lamp on the front emitting a
29	white light visible from a distance of at least five hundred feet to the



front.

- (3) Every bicycle OR EPAMD shall be equipped with a red reflector of a type approved by the department, which shall be visible for six hundred feet to the rear when directly in front of lawful lower beams of head lamps on a motor vehicle.
- (4) Every bicycle OR EPAMD when in use at the times described in section 42-4-204 shall be equipped with reflective material of sufficient size and reflectivity to be visible from both sides for six hundred feet when directly in front of lawful lower beams of head lamps on a motor vehicle or, in lieu of such reflective material, with a lighted lamp visible from both sides from a distance of at least five hundred feet.
- 11 (5) A bicycle OR EPAMD or its rider may be equipped with lights 12 or reflectors in addition to those required by subsections (2) to (4) of this 13 section.".
