Allows the governor to issue an executive order declaring a disaster emergency and designating a temporary location for the general assembly to meet in a special session if the governor determines that there is a disaster emergency that substantially affects the ability of government to operate in the city and county of Denver. Requires the governor to consult with the chief justice of the supreme court, the president of the senate, and the speaker of the house of representatives to determine a temporary safe location for the general assembly to meet in special session.

Requires the general assembly to meet in a temporary location to enact a statute adopting the location of a temporary seat of government.

Be It Resolved by the House of Representatives of the Sixty-seventh 1 General Assembly of the State of Colorado, the Senate concurring herein: 2 SECTION 1. At the next election at which such question may be 3 submitted, there shall be submitted to the registered electors of the state 4 of Colorado, for their approval or rejection, the following amendment to 5 the constitution of the state of Colorado, to wit: 6 Section 3 of article VIII of the constitution of the state of Colorado 7 is amended to read: 8 Section 3. Seat of government - how changed. (1) When the 9 seat of government shall have been located IN THE CITY AND COUNTY OF 10 DENVER as herein provided IN SECTION 2 OF THIS ARTICLE, the location 11 thereof shall not thereafter be changed, except by a vote of two-thirds of 12 all the qualified electors of the state voting on that question, at a general 13 election, at which the question of location of the seat of government shall 14 15 have been submitted by the general assembly. (2) NOTWITHSTANDING THE PROVISIONS OF SUBSECTION (1) OF 16 THIS SECTION, IF THE GOVERNOR DETERMINES THAT THERE IS A DISASTER 17

4	SECTION 3. The votes cast for the adoption or rejection of said
5	amendment shall be canvassed and the result determined in the manner
5	provided by law for the canvassing of votes for representatives in
7	Congress, and if a majority of the electors voting on the question shall
8	have voted "Yes", the said amendment shall become a part of the state
9	constitution.
