SUBJECT:

At-Risk Funding in School Finance

The following memorandum briefly describes the impact on individual schools of four proposals discussed at the August 27, 2009, interim committee meeting on school finance to create an incentive funding program for at-risk students.

Under current law, school districts receive funding for at-risk students based on a district's per pupil funding and its number and proportion of at-risk students. At-risk students are defined as those from low-income families who are eligible for free lunches under the National School Lunch Act, plus a limited number of non-English-speaking students. In the past ten years, funding for at-risk students through Colorado's school finance act has increased from \$110 million to \$246 million, or at an average annual rate of 8.4 percent. In this same time period, total program funding for schools has increased from \$3.4 billion to \$5.7 billion, or at an average annual rate of 5.3 percent.

Under the first proposal, additional incentive funding would be provided for at-risk students, equal to \$150 per at-risk student, if a school meets the following conditions:

- the school's percentage of free-lunch students is greater than or equal to 30 percent; and
- the percentage of students scoring unsatisfactory on the Colorado Student Assessment Program (CSAP) exams is less than 10 percent.

The latter condition is measured by constructing an average of each school's CSAP scores across all grades and types of exams (reading, writing, math, and science). Table 1 illustrates how the average was calculated for the Edison Elementary School in Denver Public Schools. As indicated,

there were 70 out of 706 unsatisfactory CSAP exam scores in grades 3 through 5, for an average of 9.9 percent.

Based on these two criteria, 254 schools would have qualified for incentive funding under the first proposal. These schools are listed in Appendix A. The number of free-lunch students in these schools totaled 28,264, so incentive payments would amount to \$4.2 million, at \$150 per free-lunch student. This assumes that the number of free-lunch students is equivalent to the number of at-risk students.

Because the science exam is only administered to certain grades, a second scenario used the same criteria as above, but excluded science scores. An estimated 285 schools would have qualified for incentive funding, with the number of free-lunch students in these schools totaling 34,645. Incentive payments would amount to \$5.2 million, at \$150 per at-risk student, under this scenario.

Under a third proposal, a school would qualify for incentive funding if:

- the school's percentage of free-lunch students is greater than or equal to 50 percent; and
- the percentage of students scoring unsatisfactory on the Colorado Student Assessment Program (CSAP) exams is less than 10 percent.

An estimated 76 schools would qualify for the incentive payments under this proposal and are listed in Appendix B. Assuming the same \$150 incentive payment per free-lunch student, the total cost of this proposal would be \$1.6 million.

Finally, instead of using CSAP scores to determine eligibility for the incentive program, median growth percentiles for each school were used. For a school to qualify under this scenario, its percentile scores would have to be above 50 on two of three CSAP exams and more than 50 percent of the school's students must be eligible for free-lunch. In 2008, a total of 152 schools would have qualified, representing 39 school districts. The number of free-lunch students in these schools totaled 45,714, so the cost of the program would be \$6.9 million. These schools are listed in Appendix C.
