HOUSE COMMITTEE OF REFERENCE REPORT

After consideration on the merits, the Committee recommends the following:

HB09-1200 be amended as follows:

1 Amend printed bill, strike everything below the enacting clause and
2 substitute the following:

3 "SECTION 1. Part 3 of article 1 of title 29, Colorado Revised
4 Statutes, is amended BY THE ADDITION OF A NEW SECTION to read:

5 **29-1-304.9. Fiscal Note.** (1) FOR ANY PROPOSED LEGISLATION
6 INTRODUCED AFTER DECEMBER 31, 2010, THAT HAS A FISCAL IMPACT ON
7 A COUNTY, THE STAFF OF THE LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL SHALL CONSIDER AND
8 PROVIDE IN THE LOCAL GOVERNMENT IMPACT SECTION OF THE
9 ACCOMPANYING FISCAL NOTE, WHEN POSSIBLE, TAKING INTO ACCOUNT
10 REASONABLE TIME CONSTRAINTS, THE FOLLOWING:

11 (a) A REASONABLE AND TIMELY ESTIMATE OF THE FISCAL IMPACT
12 ON THE COUNTIES CHOSEN IN ACCORDANCE WITH SUBSECTION (2) OF THIS
13 SECTION THAT WOULD RESULT FROM THE PROPOSED LEGISLATION; AND

14 (b) POTENTIAL STAFFING AND OTHER ADMINISTRATIVE ASPECTS
15 OF THE PROPOSED LEGISLATION.

16 (2) IN ORDER TO COMPILE THE INFORMATION REQUIRED BY
17 SUBSECTION (1) OF THIS SECTION, THE STAFF OF THE LEGISLATIVE
18 COUNCIL SHALL REQUEST FROM A STATEWIDE ASSOCIATION OF COUNTY
19 COMMISSIONERS, REFERRED TO IN THIS SECTION AS "COLORADO
20 COUNTIES, INCORPORATED", OR "CCI", FISCAL INFORMATION REGARDING
21 THE IMPACT OF THE PROPOSED LEGISLATION ON CERTAIN COUNTIES TO BE
22 DETERMINED BY CCI. THE INFORMATION PROVIDED BY CCI MAY INCLUDE



1 THE FISCAL IMPACT ON ANY COUNTY DIRECTLY AFFECTED BY THE
2 PROPOSED LEGISLATION. CCI MAY CONVEY THE REQUESTED INFORMATION
3 TO THE STAFF OF THE LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL WITHIN THE TIME PRESCRIBED
4 WITH A SIGNED STATEMENT VERIFYING THAT THE INFORMATION IS
5 ACCURATE AND COMPLETE TO THE BEST OF CCI'S KNOWLEDGE. IF CCI
6 RECEIVES NEW INFORMATION AT A LATER DATE, CCI MAY UPDATE ITS
7 ORIGINAL DETERMINATION OF THE FISCAL IMPACT ON THE COUNTIES
8 CHOSEN BY CCI BASED ON ACTUAL COST OR REVENUE FIGURES, IMPROVED
9 ESTIMATES, OR BOTH.

10 (3) THE STAFF OF LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL SHALL CONSIDER THE
11 INFORMATION RECEIVED FROM CCI, IF ANY, WHEN COMPLETING THE
12 LOCAL GOVERNMENT IMPACT SECTION OF ANY FISCAL NOTE.

13 **SECTION 2. Act subject to petition - effective date.** This act
14 shall take effect at 12:01 a.m. on the day following the expiration of the
15 ninety-day period after final adjournment of the general assembly that is
16 allowed for submitting a referendum petition pursuant to article V, section
17 1 (3) of the state constitution, (August 4, 2009, if adjournment sine die is
18 on May 6, 2009); except that, if a referendum petition is filed against this
19 act or an item, section, or part of this act within such period, then the act,
20 item, section, or part, if approved by the people, shall take effect on the
21 date of the official declaration of the vote thereon by proclamation of the
22 governor."

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
