After consideration on the merits, the Committee recommends the following:

SB09-256 be amended as follows:

1 Amend reengrossed bill, page 43, strike lines 1 through 10 and substitute
2 the following:

3 "(f) ENSURE THAT, BEGINNING NO LATER THAN THE 2010-11
4 SCHOOL YEAR, INSTITUTE CHARTER SCHOOLS REQUIRE STUDENT
5 INDIVIDUAL CAREER AND EDUCATION PLANS THAT MEET OR EXCEED THE
6 STANDARDS ADOPTED BY THE STATE BOARD PURSUANT TO SECTION
7 22-2-135. AN INSTITUTE CHARTER SCHOOL SHALL ASSIST EACH STUDENT
8 AND HIS OR HER PARENT OR LEGAL GUARDIAN TO DEVELOP AND MAINTAIN
9 THE STUDENT'S INDIVIDUAL CAREER AND ACADEMIC PLAN NO LATER THAN
10 THE BEGINNING OF NINTH GRADE BUT MAY ASSIST THE STUDENT AND HIS
11 OR HER PARENT OR LEGAL GUARDIAN TO DEVELOP AND MAINTAIN HIS OR
12 HER INDIVIDUAL CAREER AND ACADEMIC PLAN IN ANY GRADE PRIOR TO
13 NINTH GRADE. THE INSTITUTE CHARTER SCHOOL MAY USE ANY SOFTWARE
14 OR INTERNET-BASED COLLEGE PREPARATION AND PLANNING SERVICE THAT
15 THE INSTITUTE CHARTER SCHOOL DEEMS USEFUL AND APPROPRIATE IN
16 DEVELOPING AND MAINTAINING THE PLANS."

17 Page 49, strike lines 20 through 27.

18 Page 50, strike lines 1 through 4 and substitute the following:

19 "(mm) TO ENSURE THAT, BEGINNING NO LATER THAN THE 2010-11
20 SCHOOL YEAR, THE PUBLIC SCHOOLS OF THE SCHOOL DISTRICT, INCLUDING
21 THE CHARTER SCHOOLS, REQUIRE STUDENT INDIVIDUAL CAREER AND
22 EDUCATION PLANS THAT MEET OR EXCEED THE STANDARDS ADOPTED BY

1 THE STATE BOARD PURSUANT TO SECTION 22-2-135. A PUBLIC SCHOOL
2 SHALL ASSIST EACH STUDENT AND HIS OR HER PARENT OR LEGAL
3 GUARDIAN TO DEVELOP AND MAINTAIN THE STUDENT'S INDIVIDUAL
4 CAREER AND ACADEMIC PLAN NO LATER THAN THE BEGINNING OF NINTH
5 GRADE BUT MAY ASSIST THE STUDENT AND HIS OR HER PARENT OR LEGAL
6 GUARDIAN TO DEVELOP AND MAINTAIN HIS OR HER INDIVIDUAL CAREER
7 AND ACADEMIC PLAN IN ANY GRADE PRIOR TO NINTH GRADE. THE PUBLIC
8 SCHOOL MAY USE ANY SOFTWARE OR INTERNET-BASED COLLEGE
9 PREPARATION AND PLANNING SERVICE THAT THE PUBLIC SCHOOL DEEMS
10 USEFUL AND APPROPRIATE IN DEVELOPING AND MAINTAINING THE PLANS.

11 SECTION 25. Part 1 of article 2 of title 22, Colorado Revised
12 Statutes, is amended BY THE ADDITION OF A NEW SECTION to
13 read:

14 **22-2-135. Additional duty - state board - individual career and**
15 **academic plans - standards - rules.** (1) ON OR BEFORE FEBRUARY 1,
16 2010, THE STATE BOARD SHALL PROMULGATE RULES PURSUANT TO THE
17 "STATE ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEDURE ACT", ARTICLE 4 OF TITLE 24,
18 C.R.S., TO ESTABLISH STANDARDS FOR INDIVIDUAL CAREER AND
19 ACADEMIC PLANS FOR STUDENTS ENROLLED IN THE PUBLIC SCHOOLS IN
20 THE STATE. AN INDIVIDUAL CAREER AND ACADEMIC PLAN SHALL BE
21 DESIGNED TO ASSIST A STUDENT AND HIS OR HER PARENT OR LEGAL
22 GUARDIAN IN EXPLORING THE POSTSECONDARY CAREER AND
23 EDUCATIONAL OPPORTUNITIES AVAILABLE TO THE STUDENT, ALIGNING
24 COURSE WORK AND CURRICULUM, APPLYING TO POSTSECONDARY
25 EDUCATION INSTITUTIONS, SECURING FINANCIAL AID, AND ULTIMATELY
26 ENTERING THE WORKFORCE.

27 (2) IN ESTABLISHING THE STANDARDS FOR INDIVIDUAL CAREER
28 AND ACADEMIC PLANS, THE STATE BOARD SHALL ENSURE, AT A MINIMUM,
29 THAT:

30 (a) EACH INDIVIDUAL CAREER AND ACADEMIC PLAN INCLUDES A
31 CAREER PLANNING AND GUIDANCE COMPONENT AND A PORTFOLIO THAT
32 REFLECTS, AT A MINIMUM:

33 (I) THE STUDENT'S EFFORTS IN EXPLORING CAREERS, INCLUDING
34 INTEREST SURVEYS THAT THE STUDENT COMPLETES;

35 (II) THE STUDENT'S ACADEMIC PROGRESS, INCLUDING THE



1 COURSES TAKEN, ANY REMEDIATION OR CREDIT RECOVERY, AND ANY
2 CONCURRENT ENROLLMENT CREDITS EARNED;

3 (III) THE STUDENT'S EXPERIENCES IN CONTEXTUAL AND SERVICE
4 LEARNING;

5 (IV) THE STUDENT'S COLLEGE APPLICATIONS AND RESUME, AS
6 THEY ARE PREPARED AND SUBMITTED; AND

7 (V) THE STUDENT'S POSTSECONDARY STUDIES AS THE STUDENT
8 PROGRESSES;

9 (b) EACH INDIVIDUAL CAREER AND ACADEMIC PLAN IS ACCESSIBLE
10 TO EDUCATORS, STUDENTS, AND PARENTS; AND

11 (c) EACH PUBLIC SCHOOL, IN ASSISTING STUDENTS AND PARENTS
12 IN CREATING AND MAINTAINING THE INDIVIDUAL CAREER AND ACADEMIC
13 PLANS, IS IN COMPLIANCE WITH THE REQUIREMENTS OF THE FEDERAL
14 "FAMILY EDUCATIONAL RIGHTS AND PRIVACY ACT OF 1974", 20 U.S.C.
15 SEC. 1232g."
