LLS No. 15-0191 be amended as follows:

1 Amend LLS No. 15-0191, strike everything below the enacting clause
2 and substitute:

3 **"SECTION 1.** In Colorado Revised Statutes, 12-29.7-103, **amend**
4 (4) (a) introductory portion as follows:

5 **12-29.7-103. Definitions.** As used in this article, unless the
6 context otherwise requires:

7 (4) (a) "Athletic training" means the performance pursuant to the
8 ~~direction of a Colorado licensed or otherwise lawfully practicing~~
9 ~~physician, dentist, or health care professional~~ of those services that
10 require the education, training, and experience required by this article for
11 registration as an athletic trainer pursuant to section 12-29.7-107.
12 "Athletic training" includes services appropriate for the prevention,
13 recognition, assessment, management, treatment, rehabilitation, and
14 reconditioning of injuries and illnesses sustained by an athlete:

15 **SECTION 2.** In Colorado Revised Statutes, **amend** 12-29.7-106
16 as follows:

17 **12-29.7-106. Registration required - practice under direction**
18 **of licensed provider.** (1) Except as otherwise provided in this article, a
19 ~~person shall not~~ IN ORDER TO practice athletic training or represent
20 ~~himself or herself~~ ONESELF as being able to practice athletic training in
21 this state, ~~without possessing~~ A PERSON MUST:

22 (a) POSSESS a valid registration issued by the director in
23 accordance with this article and any rules adopted under this article; AND

24 (b) PRACTICE PURSUANT TO THE DIRECTION OF A
25 COLORADO-LICENSED OR OTHERWISE LAWFULLY PRACTICING PHYSICIAN,
26 DENTIST, OR HEALTH CARE PROFESSIONAL.

27 **SECTION 3.** In Colorado Revised Statutes, 12-29.7-109, **amend**
28 (2) (i); and **add** (2) (k) and (2) (l) as follows:

29 **12-29.7-109. Grounds for discipline - disciplinary proceedings.**

30 (2) The director may revoke, deny, suspend, or refuse to renew a
31 registration, or issue a cease-and-desist order in accordance with this
32 section upon reasonable grounds that the registrant:

33 (i) Has refused to submit to a physical or mental examination

1 when so ordered by the board pursuant to section 12-29.7-110; or
2 (k) HAS FAILED TO PRACTICE PURSUANT TO THE DIRECTION OF A
3 COLORADO-LICENSED OR OTHERWISE LAWFULLY PRACTICING PHYSICIAN,
4 DENTIST, OR HEALTH CARE PROFESSIONAL; OR

5 (l) HAS PRACTICED ATHLETIC TRAINING IN A MANNER THAT FAILS
6 TO MEET GENERALLY ACCEPTED STANDARDS OF ATHLETIC TRAINING
7 PRACTICE.

8 **SECTION 4.** In Colorado Revised Statutes, **amend** 12-29.7-114
9 as follows:

10 **12-29.7-114. Repeal of article - review of functions.** This article
11 is repealed, effective ~~July 1, 2015~~ ¹⁵ SEPTEMBER 1, 2024, and the powers,
12 duties, and functions of the director specified in this article are repealed
13 on said THAT date. Prior to the repeal, ~~such~~ THE DEPARTMENT OF
14 REGULATORY AGENCIES SHALL REVIEW THE powers, duties, and functions
15 ~~shall be reviewed~~ OF THE DIRECTOR as provided in section 24-34-104,
16 C.R.S.

17 **SECTION 5.** In Colorado Revised Statutes, 24-34-104, **repeal**
18 (46) (k); and **add** (55) (j) as follows:

19 **24-34-104. General assembly review of regulatory agencies**
20 **and functions for termination, continuation, or reestablishment.**
21 (46) The following agencies, functions, or both shall terminate on July
22 1, 2015:

23 ~~(k) The regulation of athletic trainers by the director of the~~
24 ~~division of professions and occupations in the department of regulatory~~
25 ~~agencies in accordance with article 29.7 of title 12, C.R.S.;~~

26 (55) The following agencies, functions, or both, terminate on
27 September 1, ~~2024~~: ²⁰¹⁵

28 (j) THE REGULATION OF ATHLETIC TRAINERS BY THE DIRECTOR OF
29 THE DIVISION OF PROFESSIONS AND OCCUPATIONS IN THE DEPARTMENT OF
30 REGULATORY AGENCIES IN ACCORDANCE WITH ARTICLE 29.7 OF TITLE 12,
31 C.R.S.

32 **SECTION 6. Effective date.** This act takes effect July 1, 2015.

33 **SECTION 7. Safety clause.** The general assembly hereby finds,
34 determines, and declares that this act is necessary for the immediate
35 preservation of the public peace, health, and safety."
