101 **CONCERNING THE CONTINUATION OF THE REGULATION OF MASSAGE**  
102 **PARLORS, AND, IN CONNECTION THEREWITH, REPEALING THE**  
103 **REGULATION OF MASSAGE PARLORS.**

**Bill Summary**

**Sunset Process – Senate Business, Labor, and Technology Committee.** The bill repeals the ability of certain local government to regulate massage parlors.

1 *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado:*

2           **SECTION 1.** In Colorado Revised Statutes, **repeal** article 48.5  
3 of title 12.

4           **SECTION 2.** In Colorado Revised Statutes, 24-34-104, **repeal**  
5 (46) (a) as follows:

6           **24-34-104. General assembly review of regulatory agencies**  
7 **and functions for termination, continuation, or reestablishment.**

8 (46) The following agencies, functions, or both shall terminate on July  
9 1, 2015:

10           (a) ~~The licensing of massage parlors in accordance with article~~  
11 ~~48.5 of title 12, C.R.S.;~~

12           **SECTION 3. Act subject to petition - effective date.** This act  
13 takes effect at 12:01 a.m. on the day following the expiration of the  
14 ninety-day period after final adjournment of the general assembly (August  
15 5, 2015, if adjournment sine die is on May 6, 2015); except that, if a  
16 referendum petition is filed pursuant to section 1 (3) of article V of the  
17 state constitution against this act or an item, section, or part of this act  
18 within such period, then the act, item, section, or part will not take effect  
19 unless approved by the people at the general election to be held in  
20 November 2016 and, in such case, will take effect on the date of the  
21 official declaration of the vote thereon by the governor.
