TITLE: CONCERNING THE ENCOURAGEMENT OF BREASTFEEDING, AND, IN CONNECTION THEREWITH, RECOGNIZING THE BENEFITS OF BREASTFEEDING AND PROVIDING FOR BREASTFEEDING IN PUBLIC.

Summary of Assessment

The bill declares that breastfeeding is a significant health benefit for both mothers and infants. The purpose of the bill is for the state to become involved in the national movement to recognize the medical importance of breastfeeding and to encourage removal of societal boundaries placed on breastfeeding in public. Additionally, the bill provides that a mother may breastfeed in any area that the mother is permitted to occupy. The bill is effective upon signature of the Governor. The bill is assessed at having no state or local government fiscal impact.
