TITLE: CONCERNING A PROHIBITION OF A STATEWIDE CONCEALED HANDGUN PERMIT DATABASE.

Summary of Assessment

This bill prohibits law enforcement agencies from maintaining a statewide concealed handgun permit database. Current law allows county sheriffs to maintain a list of persons who have a permit, and this is still allowable under this bill.

The statewide concealed carry database maintained by the Department of Public Safety currently contains about 24,000 names. Permittees have to re-apply for permits every 5 years, with the first renewal year occurring in 2 years. The elimination of this database will result in a nominal cost savings for the department, since they will no longer have to maintain the database. Thus, the bill will not affect state or local revenue or expenditures, and is assessed as having no fiscal impact. The bill was postponed indefinitely by the Senate State, Veterans and Military Affairs Committee on January 29, 2007.
