**Description of Amendments in This Packet**

**J.001** Staff has prepared amendment **J.001** (attached) to add a provision appropriating \$61,491 cash funds from the Illegal Drug Laboratory Fund and 0.5 FTE to the Department of Public Health and Environment, Hazardous Materials and Waste Management Division for FY 2013-14. Of this amount, \$15,450 and 0.1 FTE is reappropriated to the Department of Law for the provision of legal services in FY 2013-14.
