As discussed in the Legislative Council Staff Fiscal Note dated February 8, 2013, the bill raises both legal and practical questions concerning the state's ability to require the federal government to transfer title of all agricultural public lands to the state, resulting in uncertainty regarding the likely fiscal impact of the bill.
