14	(f) Upon request by the chief information officer, to advise the
15	chief information officer on other issues pertaining to education data
16	sharing; AND
17	(g) To identify a method or methods, if feasible, for
18	ASSIGNING A UNIQUE STUDENT IDENTIFIER AS PART OF THE DEPARTMENT
19	OF EDUCATION RECORD INTEGRATION TRACKING SYSTEM OR AN
20	ALTERNATIVE TRACKING SYSTEM EMPLOYING INTERAGENCY
21	DATA-SHARING, FOR EACH PERSON ENROLLED IN AN ADULT BASIC
22	EDUCATION PROGRAM OR HIGH SCHOOL GENERAL EQUIVALENCY DIPLOMA
23	PROGRAM.".
