A BILL FOR AN ACT

101 **CONCERNING THE ABILITY OF A PEACE OFFICER TO OBTAIN AN**
102 **ALCOHOL BEVERAGE LICENSE.**

Bill Summary

(Note: This summary applies to this bill as introduced and does not reflect any amendments that may be subsequently adopted. Current law prohibits a peace officer from obtaining an alcohol beverage license issued under the "Colorado Liquor Code". The bill repeals this prohibition.

1 *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado:*

2 **SECTION 1.** In Colorado Revised Statutes, 12-47-307, **amend**
3 (2) as follows:

4 **12-47-307. Persons prohibited as licensees.** (2) (a) No license
5 provided by this article shall be issued to or held by ~~any peace officer, or~~
6 the state licensing authority or any of its inspectors or employees.

7 (b) A PEACE OFFICER DESCRIBED IN SECTION 16-2.5-103,
8 16-2.5-105, 16-2.5-108, 16-2.5-132, OR 16-2.5-149, C.R.S., MAY NOT
9 OBTAIN OR HOLD A LICENSE UNDER THIS ARTICLE TO OPERATE A LICENSED
10 PREMISES THAT IS LOCATED WITHIN THE SAME JURISDICTION THAT
11 EMPLOYS THE PEACE OFFICER.

12 **SECTION 2. Act subject to petition - effective date.** This act
13 takes effect at 12:01 a.m. on the day following the expiration of the
14 ninety-day period after final adjournment of the general assembly (August
15 7, 2013, if adjournment sine die is on May 8, 2013); except that, if a
16 referendum petition is filed pursuant to section 1 (3) of article V of the
17 state constitution against this act or an item, section, or part of this act
18 within such period, then the act, item, section, or part will not take effect
19 unless approved by the people at the general election to be held in
20 November 2014 and, in such case, will take effect on the date of the
21 official declaration of the vote thereon by the governor.
