A BILL FOR AN ACT

101 **CONCERNING THE CREATION OF A CIVIL AIR PATROL LICENSE PLATE,**
102 **AND, IN CONNECTION THEREWITH, MAKING AN APPROPRIATION.**

Bill Summary

(Note: This summary applies to this bill as introduced and does not reflect any amendments that may be subsequently adopted. If this bill passes third reading in the house of introduction, a bill summary that applies to the reengrossed version of this bill will be available at <http://www.leg.state.co.us/billsummaries>.)

The bill creates the civil air patrol license plate. In addition to the normal motor vehicle fees, the plate requires 2 one-time fees of \$25. One of the fees is credited to the highway users tax fund and the other to the licensing services cash fund.

1 *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado:*

2 **SECTION 1.** In Colorado Revised Statutes, 42-3-213, **add** (1) (a)
3 (XXV) and (26) as follows:

4 **42-3-213. Special plates - military veterans - rules - retirement.**

5 (1) (a) The department shall issue one or more sets of special license
6 plates to the following persons who own a truck that does not exceed
7 sixteen thousand pounds empty weight, a passenger car, a motorcycle, or
8 a noncommercial or recreational vehicle:

9 (XXV) A NATURAL PERSON WHO SUPPORTS THE CIVIL AIR PATROL.

10 (26) **Member of the Civil Air Patrol.** (a) THE DEPARTMENT OF
11 MILITARY AFFAIRS MAY DESIGN THE CIVIL AIR PATROL LICENSE PLATE IF
12 THE DESIGN CONFORMS WITH STANDARDS ESTABLISHED BY THE
13 DEPARTMENT AND INDICATES THAT AN OWNER OF A MOTOR VEHICLE TO
14 WHICH THE PLATE IS ATTACHED SUPPORTS THE CIVIL AIR PATROL.

15 (b) A NATURAL PERSON WHO SUPPORTS THE CIVIL AIR PATROL MAY
16 USE A CIVIL AIR PATROL LICENSE PLATE.

17 **SECTION 2. Appropriation.** (1) In addition to any other
18 appropriation, there is hereby appropriated, out of any moneys in the
19 Colorado state titling and registration account of the highway users tax
20 fund created in section 42-1-211 (2), Colorado Revised Statutes, not
21 otherwise appropriated, to the department of revenue, for the fiscal year
22 beginning July 1, 2013, the sum of \$2,972, or so much thereof as may be
23 necessary, to be allocated to the information technology division for the
24 purchase of computer programming services related to the
25 implementation of this act.

26 (2) In addition to any other appropriation, there is hereby

1 appropriated, out of any moneys in the license plate cash fund created in
2 section 42-3-301 (1) (b), Colorado Revised Statutes, not otherwise
3 appropriated, to the department of revenue, for the fiscal year beginning
4 July 1, 2013, the sum of \$633, or so much thereof as may be necessary,
5 for allocation to the division of motor vehicles for the purchase of special
6 license plates related to the implementation of this act.

7 (3) In addition to any other appropriation, there is hereby
8 appropriated to the governor - lieutenant governor - state planning and
9 budgeting, for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2013, the sum of \$2,972,
10 or so much thereof as may be necessary, for allocation to the office of
11 information technology, for the provision of computer center services for
12 the department of revenue related to the implementation of this act. Said
13 sum is from reappropriated funds received from the department of
14 revenue out of the appropriation made in subsection (1) of this section.

15 **SECTION 3. Act subject to petition - effective date -**
16 **applicability.** (1) This act takes effect at 12:01 a.m. on the day following
17 the expiration of the ninety-day period after final adjournment of the
18 general assembly (August 7, 2013, if adjournment sine die is on May 8,
19 2013); except that, if a referendum petition is filed pursuant to section 1
20 (3) of article V of the state constitution against this act or an item, section,
21 or part of this act within such period, then the act, item, section, or part
22 will not take effect unless approved by the people at the general election
23 to be held in November 2014 and, in such case, will take effect on the
24 date of the official declaration of the vote thereon by the governor.

25 (2) This act applies to license plate applications issued on or after
26 the January 1, 2014.
