The bill requires but does not contain an appropriation clause.

Description of Amendments in This Packet

J.001 Staff has prepared amendment **J.001** (attached) to add a provision appropriating \$8,882 cash funds to the Department of Revenue for FY 2013-14, of which \$2,972 is from the Colorado State Titling and Registration Account in the Highway Users Tax Fund for programming changes and \$5,920 is from the License Plate Cash Fund for the purchase of the special license plates from the Department of Corrections, Correctional Industries. The \$2,972 for programming costs is reappropriated to the Governor's Office of Information Technology.
