

State Expenditures

The bill increases General Fund expenditures by \$400,000 to the commission's cash fund in FY 2014-15. The cash fund is continuously appropriated to the commission. This appropriation is assumed to be from the General Fund. To fulfill its duties, the commission may use these funds to hire administrative staff or purchase access to databases in order to perform empirical analyses. The commission may also purchase contract services from health care experts or organizations. Voting members may require reimbursement for travel expenses related to fulfilling their duties on the commission.

Effective Date

The bill takes effect upon signature of the Governor, or upon becoming law without his signature.

State Appropriations

The bill appropriates \$400,000 from the General Fund to the Colorado Commission on Affordable Health Care Cash Fund. Moneys in the cash fund are continuously appropriated to the commission.
